EAST BAY REGIONAL PARK DISTRICT

The below field trip has been scheduled for the East Bay Regional Park District Board of Directors.

This field trip will commence at **10:00 a.m.** on **Friday, September 11, 2009**, at EBRPD Headquarters, 2950 Peralta Oaks Court, Oakland, California. It is anticipated that the group will return to Headquarters at approximately **3:30 p.m.**

***Depart Peralta Oaks** **10:00 a.m.**

Arrive Redwood Regional Park **10:20 a. m.**

The Board will be visiting the site of serpentine prairie restoration project near the Richard C. Trudeau Training Center.

[Note: Anyone who wants to join the field trip for the tour of Redwood Regional Park serpentine prairie restoration project near the Richard C. Trudeau Training Center at 11500 Skyline Blvd. Oakland, CA., should meet at the parking lot at 10:15 a.m. To reach the meeting site coming south (from downtown Oakland) take 580 freeway; then take 35th Avenue exit; turn left and go up 35th Ave. (35th Ave. becomes Redwood Rd.), continue to Skyline Blvd.; make a left on Skyline to 11500 Skyline Blvd. Coming north (from Hayward) take 580 freeway to Hwy 13; exit Redwood Road and continue straight; turn right onto Redwood Road, make a left on Skyline Blvd. to 11500 Skyline Blvd.]

Arrive Redwood Regional Park **11:00 a. m.**

The Board will be visiting the site of a fuel reduction project on East Ridge Trail near the Skyline Gate Staging area.

[Note: Anyone who wants to join the field trip for the fuel reduction project on East Ridge Trail near Skyline Gate should be at Skyline Gate by 10:45 a.m. You will first reach the 11500 Skyline Boulevard staging area on the right (the former administrative headquarters (see directions above) immediately past that, turn right to remain on Skyline Boulevard (otherwise the roadway becomes Joaquin Miller Road and you will proceed downhill). A few miles farther on Skyline you will pass Roberts Regional Recreation Area. Continue for approximately 2.2 miles and you will reach 8500 Skyline Blvd., the Skyline Gate Staging area.]

Arrive Sibley **12:00 p.m.**

The Board will be visiting the site of new backpack camp and a new staging area at the park.

[Note: Anyone who wants to join the field trip for the tour at Sibley Park should be on site at the Skyline Blvd. Staging area by 11:45 a.m. From Hwy 24 eastbound (east end of the Caldecott Tunnel), take the Fish Ranch Road exit go north, uphill, for .8 miles to Grizzly Peak Blvd., turn left and go 2.4 miles to Skyline Blvd., turn left on Skyline and proceed to the staging area (parking lot) at 6800 Skyline Blvd.]

Arrive Tilden Golf Course

12:45 p.m.

The Board will be visiting the Tilden Golf Course to receive an update on the golf operations.

[Note: Anyone who wants to join the field trip for the Tilden Golf Course update should be on site by 12:30 p.m. Going north (from Hayward) take 580 to Hwy. 13 (Warren Freeway) go through the Caldecott Tunnel (stay in the right hand bore) take 1st exit, which is Fish Ranch Road and go up hill to Grizzly Peak Blvd.; turn right; then turn right on Golf Course Road.; go down about 1/3 of a mile to parking lot on right; meeting is at the Grizzly Grill.]

Arrive Lone Oak Picnic Area, Tilden Regional Park

2:00 p.m.

The Board will be visiting the Lone Oak area to see a completed fuel reduction project.

[Note: Anyone who wants to join the field trip to visit the Lone Oak project should be there at 1:45 p.m. Go north from east Oakland (2950 Peralta Oaks Court), take 580 to Hwy. 13 (Warren Freeway) go through the Caldecott tunnel (stay in the right hand bore) take 1st exit, which is Fish Ranch Road and go up hill to Grizzly Peak Blvd.; turn right; pass the Steam Train, turn right on South Park Drive to bottom of hill; turn left on Wildcat Canyon Rd., right on Central Park Drive (will pass the Merry-Go-Round), turn right on Lone Oak Road; you will see the picnic area, approximately 1/10 mile ahead on the right.]

Return to Peralta Oaks

3:30 p.m.

***If anyone is planning to join the field trip at Peralta Oaks, they should arrive no later than 9:45 a.m.**

Coming from the West (downtown Oakland area)

[Take Hwy. 580 West (towards Hayward). Exit at 106th Avenue. Make three immediate lefts; then go straight until you reach 106th Avenue turn left, you will go under the freeway overpass. Make the first right onto Peralta Oaks Drive. Then, make a left onto Peralta Oaks Court. You may park on the street or you may pull into the breezeway, please park in “visitor parking.”]

Coming from the East (Hayward area)

[Take Hwy. 580 West (towards Oakland). Exit Foothill Blvd/MacArthur Blvd. Stay to the right and make the first slight right turn onto Foothill Blvd. at the stop sign, make a right onto 106th Avenue, which will take you under the freeway overpass. Make the next right onto Peralta Oaks Drive. Then, make a left onto Peralta Oaks Court. You may park on the street or you may pull in the breezeway, please park in “visitor parking.”]
